Tournament Rules

- 1. Players will start with 15,000 in tournament chips. This is a two-day tournament with five starting flights.
- Players may register for Day 1A, and/or Day 1B and/or Day 1C and/ or Day 1D and/ or Day 1E. If a player enters into any starting day and is eliminated from that tournament, that player may Re-enter or register for subsequent day(s).
- On-Site Registration available until the start of Level 9. Players may Re-Enter until the start of Level 9.
- Players participating in multiple Day 1's may choose their "best" stack for start of Day 2.
- 5. Alternates and late sign-ups will enter the tournament with a full chip stack and no obligation from it.
- 6. Length of Levels: 30 Minutes
- 7. Day 1 will end after Level 14 or at TD discretion. All chips will be bagged and tagged after each flight. Day 2 will play to completion. Tournament Director will have final say in all matters concerning the length of play in tournaments.
- 8. Ante will come from the Big Blind ONLY. Ante is posted prior to Big Blind.
- 9. Redraw at end of Day 1. Redraw for seats and tables at 27 and 10 players; or at discretion of Tournament Director.
- 10. Tournament Director Decisions are final.
- 11. Management reserves the right to alter, change, or cancel this tournament. Management will not be held responsible in the event of typographical errors or misinformation on the website or printed material pertaining to this event, and players will have no claim in these matters.
- 12. Any unauthorized chips introduced into tournament play will be immediately removed upon detection without substitution. Any parties determined to be responsible for the introduction of said chips will be disqualified without refund. It's each and every player's responsibility to bring to management's attention unusual chips, circumstances, or irregularities.
- 13. Residents of foreign countries without a U.S. tax treaty will be subject to withholding.
- 14. Tournament tickets are non-refundable and nontransferable. Seating may be limited for this event.
- \$120 entry fee will be used to fund the prize pool. \$30 is the registration fee of which \$10 goes towards staffing.
- 16. 1 in 15 players will be in the money.
