- Players will start with 30,000 in tournament chips. Player may choose to play Flight A or B.
- All "ring" events qualify to earn points for the 2020 WSOP Global Casino Championship. Must be 21 years old to be eligible for Global Casino Championship or points. Winner will also receive a seat into 2020 WSOP Global Casino Championship.
- Day 1 will end at the conclusion of level 15. Day 2 will resume at 12PM the following day and will end at the conclusion of level 25 or official final table whichever comes first or Tournament Director's discretion. Day 3 will resume Monday, February 17th at 12 PM and will play until completion. 40 minutes dinner break after completion of level 9 and 60 minutes dinner break after completion of level 21. Tournament Director's discretion may be used.
- Registration will be open until the beginning of level 13. Eliminated players are allowed one re-entry per flight.
- A single ante will be paid from the big blind for the entire table. Big blind is posted prior to ante.
- Any unauthorized chips introduced into tournament play will be immediately removed upon detection without substitution. Any parties determined to be responsible for the introduction of said chips will be disqualified without refund. It's every player's responsibility to bring to management's attention unusual chips, circumstances, or irregularities.
- Residents of foreign countries without U.S. tax treaty will be subject to withholding.
