#### **Tournament Rules**

- Players will start with 40,000 in tournament chips. This is a two-day 1. tournament with three starting flights.
- 2. Players may register for all day one flights. If a player enters into any starting day and is eliminated from that tournament, that player may re-enter or register for subsequent day(s).
- On-site registration and unlimited re-entries are available until the start 3. of Level 9 of each starting day of this event.
- Players participating in multiple Day 1's may choose their best stack for 4. the start of Day 2 and forfeit other bag(s).
- 5. Alternates and late sign-ups will enter the tournament with a full chip stack and no obligation from it.
- 6. Length of Levels will last 30 minutes.
- Day 1 will end at the completion of level 16 or reach to 10% pf the field 7. whichever comes first or at TD discretion. All chips will be bagged and tagged after each flight. Day 2 will play to completion.
- 8. Ante will come from the Big Blind ONLY. Ante is posted prior to Big Blind.
- Redraw at end of Day 1, 24 players, and 9 players; or at discretion of 9. Tournament Director.
- 10. Tournament Director decisions are final. Tournament Directors Association (TDA) rules will be used throughout the tournament. Seminole Hard Rock Hotel & Casino Tampa house rule shall apply if in conflict with TDA rules. For TDA rules and regulations, check www.pokertda.com.
- 11. Any unauthorized chips introduced into tournament play will be immediately removed upon detection without substitution. Any parties determined to be responsible for the introduction of said chips will be disqualified without refund. It's each and every player's responsibility to bring to management's attention unusual chips, circumstances, or irregularities.
- 12. Residents of foreign countries without a U.S. tax treaty will be subject to withholding.
- 13. Tournament tickets are non-refundable and non-transferable. Seating may be limited for this event.
