ACCEPTABLE FORMS OF IDENTIFICATION

REQUIRED FOR W2-G, 1099's, and 1042s WINS

Health insurance cards, auto insurance cards and credit cards will no longer be accepted as secondary forms of identification

<p>Any unexpired and dated photo identification card or document issued by the U.S. Government (i.e. Diplomat Driver's License issued by the Department of State) or foreign government that can be verified.</p> <p>Below are some examples (however, this list is not all inclusive):</p> <p>Driver's license; or</p> <p>U.S. Military identification card; or</p> <p>State issued identification card; or</p> <p>U.S. or foreign passport; or</p> <p>Tribal photo identification card; or</p> <p>Foreign or non-resident alien identification card; or Resident Alien Card (Green Card)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Social Security Card • Voters Registration • Insurance Card (Medicare/Medicaid) • Government Issued ID (Local, State, Tribal, Federal) • Racing License • State Issued Gaming License • County Welfare ID • County, Municipal or State Work Identification • Firearms Permit/License • Concealed Weapons Permit/License • Boat License • Pilot License/Certification • Department of Veterans ID • US Military Identification Card (tan colored, DD Form 1173) • US DOD Guard and Reserve Dependent ID Card (red, DD Form 1173-1)

All identification must be valid (non-expired)
Management has the discretion to accept/approve acceptable ID.
