## Tournament Rules

1. Players will start with 20,000 in tournament chips. This is a twoday tournament with six starting days.
2. On-Site Registration and unlimited Re-Entry are available until the start of level 9. Tournament tickets are non-refundable and non-transferable.
3. Pre-purchased stacks and stacks for satellite winners will be "live" on the table from the beginning of the tournament. Alternates and late sign-ups will enter the tournament with a full chip stack and no obligation from it. Availability is limited, alternates and late sign-ups may have to wait for a seating assignment. Alternates and late sign-ups may be seated on the same table.
4. Players may forfeit their stack to Re-Enter. Players may bag and play a subsequent flights. Best stack will move forward, additional bags will receive minimum payouts. Players must bag chips to move on to day 2. Players are in the money on Day 2.
5. A single ante will be paid from the big blind for the entire table. The ante is paid before the Big Blind.
6. Level 1-19 will last 30 minutes each, level $20+$ will be 40 minutes. Levels will be 30 minutes Heads-Up.
7. Tables will be 8 - Handed. 1 in 10 (10\%) will be in the money. Day 1 will end at $10 \%$ of the field remaining. Day 2 will play down to a winner.
8. A redraw will occur at the end of Day 1. Players will also redraw at 24 and 9 players or at Tournament Director's discretion.
9. Any unauthorized chips introduced into tournament play will be immediately removed upon detection without substitution. Any parties determined to be responsible for the introduction of said chips will be disqualified without refund. It's each and every player's responsibility to bring to management's attention unusual chips, circumstances, or irregularities.
10. Residents of foreign countries without a U.S. tax treaty will be subject to withholding.
11. $\$ 160$ entry fee will be used to fund the prize pool. $\$ 40$ is a registration fee of which $\$ 15$ will go towards staffing and $\$ 1$ will go towards the promotional fund.
