**Tournament Rules:**

1. Players will start with 40,000 in tournament chips. This is a four-day tournament with three starting days.
2. 1 in 8 (12.5%) will be in the money.
3. On-Site Registration and Unlimited Re-Entry are available until the start of Level 10.
4. Pre-purchased stacks and stacks for satellite winners will be “live” on the table from the beginning of the tournament.
5. Players may register for Day 1A, and/or Day 1B, and/or Day 1C. If player entered into any starting day and has been eliminated from tournament, player may Re-Enter or Register for subsequent starting day(s). Players may bag and play a subsequent flight, Best Stack Forward applies, and lower chip count qualified bags will be removed. Players may forfeit their stacks to Re-Enter.
6. Alternates and late sign-ups will enter the tournament with a full chip stack and no obligation from it. Availability is limited, alternates and late sign-ups may have to wait for a seating assignment. Alternates and late sign-ups may be seated on the same table.
7. A single ante will be paid from the big blind for the entire table. The ante is paid before the Big Blind.
8. Levels 1 - 19 will last 40 minutes each. Levels 20+ will be 60 minutes until Heads-Up which will be 30 minutes.
9. Day 1 will end after completion of level 13. Day 2 will end after completion of level 23. Day 3 will play till 9 handed final table is formed or at Tournament Director’s discretion. Day 4 will play to completion.
10. Day 1 tables will be 9-handed. Day 2, Day 3 table will be 8 handed.
11. A redraw will occur at the end of Day 1, 2 & 3. Players will also redraw at 24, 16, and 9 players or at Tournament Director’s discretion.
12. Any unauthorized chips introduced into tournament play will be immediately removed upon detection without substitution. Any parties determined to be responsible for the introduction of said chips will be disqualified without refund. It’s each and every player’s responsibility to bring to management’s attention unusual chips, circumstances, or irregularities.
13. Residents of foreign countries without a U.S. tax treaty will be subject to withholding.
14. Tournament tickets are non-refundable and non-transferable.
15. \$1,500 entry fee will be used to fund the prize pool. \$200 is a registration fee of which \$50 will go towards staffing.
