Tournament Rules:

- 1. Players will start with 30,000 in tournament chips.
- 2. Levels 1-16 will last 25 minutes each. Levels 17+ will last 30 minutes each. This is a one day tournament
- 3. On-site registration and unlimited re-entries available until the start of level 9. Players may forfeit their tournament chips at the end of registration to re-enter.
- 4. Entries purchased prior to the start of the tournament will be considered live and in play. Alternates and entries purchased after the start of the tournament will have no obligation and will not be live until the player has been dealt in. Alternates and late entries may have to wait for a seating assignment. Alternates not sat during the registration period will be entitled to a refund.
- 5. This tournament is played in big blind ante format. A single ante will be owed from the big blind in the amount of the blind level each hand. The ante is paid before the

- 7. Any unauthorized chips introduced into tournament play will be immediately removed upon detection without substitution. Any parties determined to be responsible of the foreign chips will be disqualified with no refund. It is all tournament player's responsibility to bring to management's attention unusual chips, circumstances or irregularities. Tournament Director's decisions are final. Should a patron wish to dispute that decision, they may file a formal dispute with the Seminole Tribal Gaming Commission.
- 8. Residents of foreign countries without a U.S. tax treaty will be subject to tax withholdings.
- 9. Tournament entries are non-transferable and non-refundable. Entries won through Poker Room promotions into this tournament are non-transferable and non-refundable.
