Tournament Rules:

1. Players will start with 20,000 in tournament chips.
2. Levels will last 20 minutes each. This is a one-day tournament.
3. On-site registration and unlimited re-entries available until the start of level 7. Players may forfeit their tournament chips at the end of registration to re-enter.
4. Entries purchased prior to the start of the tournament will be considered live and in play. Alternates and entries purchased after the start of the tournament will have no obligation and will not be live until the player has been dealt in. Alternates and late entries may have to wait for a seating assignment. Alternates not sat during the registration period will be entitled to a refund.
5. This tournament is played in big blind ante format. A single ante will be owed from the big blind in the amount of the blind level each hand. The big blind is paid before the ante.
6. Management reserves the right to alter, change or cancel this tournament. Management will not be held responsible in the event of typographical errors or misinformation on websites or printed materials and players will have no claim in these matters.
7. Any unauthorized chips introduced into tournament play will be immediately removed upon detection without substitution. Any parties determined to be responsible of the foreign chips will be disqualified with no refund. It is all tournament player's responsibility to bring to management's attention unusual chips, circumstances or irregularities. Tournament Director's decisions are final. Should a patron wish to dispute that decision, they may file a formal dispute with the Seminole Tribal Gaming Commission.
8. Residents of foreign countries without a U.S. tax treaty will be subject to tax withholdings.
9. Tournament entries are non-transferable and non-refundable. Entries won through Poker Room promotions into this tournament are non-transferable and non-refundable.
10. A player who accumulates 220,000 in tournament chips (The Milestone) or more will instantly be awarded one (1) tournament prize. Upon verification from the tournament supervisor that the player has achieved the Milestone, the player will cease play, and the total of his/her chips will be removed from play.
11. The tournament will conclude when the number of players remaining is equal to the number of \$1,700 prizes generated, less the number of players who have previously won the prize by reaching the milestone.
12. While the tournament staff will make the best effort to identify players as they achieve the Milestone, it is the responsibility of each individual entrant to notify the dealer or Tournament Supervisor when they have reached 220,000 in tournament chips.
13. A player who is dealt into a subsequent hand after achieving the Milestone will be required to complete the hand prior to being awarded the Tournament Prize. If, at the completion of the additional hand, a player's chip total falls below the Milestone they are not eligible to receive the Tournament Prize until their chip total is once again equal to or greater than 220,000.
14. A Tournament supervisor must be called to verify the tournament chip count of a player who is making a claim for a Tournament Prize. Players may request that a Tournament supervisor count their stack at any times between hands.
15. Tournament chips must remain in full stacks of twenty (20) chips when available.
16. \$170 entry fee will be used to fund the prize pool. \$30 is a registration fee of which \$10 will go towards staffing fee & \$1 will go towards poker promotional funds.
17. One (1) in every ten (10) entries will receive a seat into **\$1,700 Seminole Hard Rock Tampa Poker Classic Event 8C held on Friday, May 2nd, 2025 at 11AM**. Residual cash will be paid to the player who finishes next after all \$1,700 prize have been awarded. Satellite winners will be registered into the first available flight, and chips will be in play when tournament starts.
